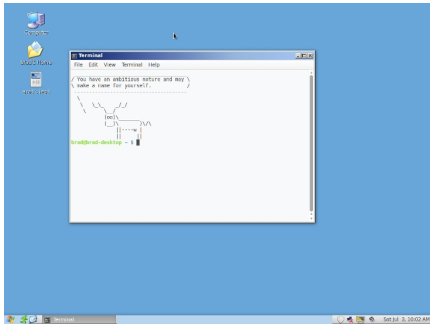


## Changing Ubuntu's look: Windows 2000

First of all download this archive, it has the two files that you will need for the customizing.

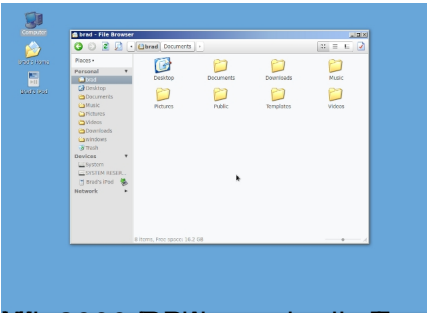
